Description	Symbiosis between town planning and the watchmaking industry, the towns of La Chaux-de-Fonds and Le Locle were listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in June 2009. They form an exceptional testimony illustrating the industrial era from the end of the 18th century to These days. Le Locle is above all an atmosphere that can be discovered through its relaxed cafes, its market and its charming guest houses, such as Maison Dubois, one of the oldest watchmaking houses in Switzerland. In the afternoon, visit the International Watch Museum at La Chaux de Fonds. The most important museum specializing in watchmaking in the world: 4,000 pieces to discover. This unique museum tells the story of time through the exceptional pieces on display: from the sundial to the atomic clock, including splendid watches and clocks, goldsmith's jewelry and scientific techniques.
